Overview of the department:

The middle and high school art rooms are very well-equipped and generously sized, allowing students to look at the contemporary and traditional aspects of the subject. The state-of-the-art suites include a laser cutter, 3D printer, dark room, kiln, and printing press, helping to provide an enriching and challenging US National Coalition for Core Arts Standards (NCCAS) and I.B. curriculum for the students.

The Role of the Middle and High School Art Technician:

- Help with prep and setup for classes and tidy up afterward.
- Work easily with two teachers, spending half the day in the middle school and half the day in the high school art room.
- Trial units of work in advance, in consultation with the teacher.
- Update the main displays in and around the room.
- Help with the preparation of the annual exhibition.
- Audit equipment and support the art teacher with the annual ordering cycle.
- Maintaining art supplies and maintaining machinery throughout the year. Training is provided for the latter if required.
- Provide clerical/administrative support, e.g., photocopying, typing, filing, etc.
- Supervise and support pupils in the subject's practical and theoretical aspects of the course components.
- Establish good relationships with pupils, act as a role model, and respond appropriately to individual needs.
- Promote the inclusion and acceptance of all pupils.
